Friendly Neighborhood Reminders

Parents: The weather is getting nicer and the days are getting longer, so the kids will want to be outside playing more often. Please make sure your kids practice street safety whether playing ball or riding bikes and scooters. Also, remember that play equipment is not to be stored in front yards in plain view from the street.

Drivers: Please use caution while driving around corners and parked cars. Keep your eyes open for kids who will be out playing and could dart in front of you. Obey posted stop signs and the speed limit of 25 mph. Please do not park in front of mail boxes during the day. Also review Article 7.7 in our CC&R's that specifically address the limitation of parking vehicles on the street for an extended period of time.

Homeowners: Spring is here! Get a jump start on a greener lawn this season by fertilizing now. Also, remember that aerating your lawn will help with water drainage issues later.



Remember all unfinished landscaping and projects required in our CC&R's (see Articles 7.9: landscaping and 7.10 Fencing) need to be completed by April 30, 2006. Our covenants require that these projects be completed six months after occupancy, so everyone has had ample time for completion. Any questions should be directed to MGM Management who will assist us in enforcing our CC&R's again in April now that winter is behind us.

Christmas Decorations: Thank you to everyone who participated in the annual Holiday Light Display Contest. We are still seeing a few left over decorations and would like to remind everyone that its time to pack them away again until next year. Thank you.

Park Rules: Please adhere to park rules. Children should not be in the parks after sunset. Remember to pick up after your pet. Parents please talk to your kids about taking pride in our parks & equipment.
